This HPD covers High Grade and/or Special High Grade zinc, which are comprised of 99% zinc metal. When applied to the steel product, the zinc coating will account for approximately 2% of the final material weight. This HPD takes into account the 2% zinc coating as well as the base steel - making it a complete HPD for a hot-dip galvanized steel product processed in a kettle with high grade or special high grade zinc.
